

### **Primary Poly Fields Elements**

- Football/Soccer/Athletics Stadium (300 seats)
- Baseball Stadium (174 seats)
- Six Tennis Courts w/seating
- Training Facility (11,835 sf)
- Fitness Center (gymnasium, 6800 sf)
- Wellness Center (4520 sf)
- Coaches Building (3605 sf)
- Lounge (1320 sf)
- Equipment Storage Facility (3995 sf)
- Lighting & Amplified Sound
- Security Lodge (500 sf)
- Multipurpose Environmental Education Buildings (2120 sf)

- Chaney Trail Sole Public Ingress/Egress
  - Primary N-S routes: Lincoln Avenue, Fair Oaks Avenue
- Subterranean Parking (208 spaces)
- Borders Significant Ecological Area
- Borders Hillside Management Areas
- Borders Rural Dark-Sky Zone
  - Up to twelve 75-foot light poles
  - Up to eight 30-foot light poles
  - Main stadium is 100-150 feet higher than homes to south
- Removal of 241 tress, including seven protected oaks

#### PETITION OF OPPOSITION

We OPPOSE the plans of Polytechnic School in Pasadena to build a sports complex on Chaney Trail in the northern Altadena foothills. The proposed development site is adjacent to the Angeles National Forest/San Gabriel Mountains National Monument and located within a State-designated Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone. The plans to build new athletic facilities and the many hundreds of additional visitors crowding an already narrow and hilly access road will dramatically increase the risks to public safety. If approved, the sports complex will fundamentally change the semi-rural characteristics of the surrounding neighborhood, with impacts propagating throughout the Altadena foothills and the Angeles National Forest/San Gabriel Mountains National Monument.
