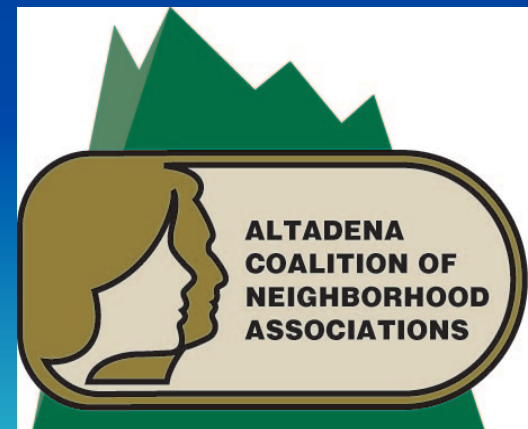

# Parking Questions

- What are the parking "laws" in Altadena?
- Are the parking "laws" different by area in Altadena?
  - For example, at the top of Loma Alta and Lake where hikers park?
- Can you park your cars in front of open driveways on residential streets?
- Who do residents of Altadena call for parking issues?
- What about school areas where parents park on residential areas?  
Sometimes that blocks spaces for the residents
- Who should residents call about parking issues, the CHP, the Sheriff, who?
- Are there parking ordinances in LA County? If so, what are they and are they different from Altadena?





# Traffic Questions

- What are the speed limits in the residential areas of Altadena?
- What are the speed limits in the business areas of Altadena?
- What about Woodbury? Is it true that the speed limit changes depending on which stretch you are on... in Pasadena, or LA County?
- What can residents do if they have speeding problems on their residential street?
- What steps have to be taken to get "speed bumps" or "traffic lights"?  
What are the most frequent issues which CHP officers have to respond to/issue tickets or warnings, for drivers in Altadena?



# 911 Questions

- Is it true that if someone calls 911 from a Cell Phone in Altadena, for an emergency, the call goes to the CHP vs. a paramedical dispatch?  
What number should call phone or residential phone callers use for
  1. Car/traffic/accident related emergencies?
  2. Other traffic and parking related issues?
